
2025 EduCare Program Fact Sheet

EIEC EduCare Program is a fully funded travel and cultural homestay program with strong education component. It provides insight to the Chinese culture and lifestyle by living with the locals while travelling at one's free time. The host benefit from learning English and respective culture from the participant. The EduCare Participants provide voluntary educational assistance to the host voluntarily and do not receive any pocket money from the Host Family.

Length of Program: 30 days, 60 days, other length will be reviewed case by case

Location: Beijing, Shanghai, Hangzhou, other cities possible upon request

Application Process involves: Application form, self-introduction video, photos/videos, education certificate, medical form

Matching Process involves: Online interview, mutual matching with one or multiple host families at a time

Arrival Process involves: Local police station registration, possible medical check as per request by host family

Participant Training: An experienced EIEC mentor will provide webinar before departure, then follows up online within the 1st week of arrival. A local coordinator will home visit participant within a few days and provide a welcome orientation to the EduCarer.

Arrival pick up: A EIEC representative or the host family will pick up participant at final destination airport. Between June and August, EIEC may offer group arrival orientation in either Beijing, Shanghai or Hangzhou.

Visa: EIEC's host family helps assist EduCarer apply for a L(Tourist) visa.

Fees:

- EIEC collects a Program Deposit at 300USD upon match.
- For departures from/to North America, an Airfare Add-on at 500USD applies, this fee is not refundable once the air ticket has been issued.
- Medical check and visa application fees are to be paid by the applicant.
- Round flights are included. EIEC books inbound flight upon match and issues return ticket upon successful program completion.
- Travel costs to/from main intl' airport in one's home country is borne by participant.

*** This Deposit can only be returned upon program successful completion. Successful completion is defined as fulfilling the committed program period and getting written approval from Host Family.*

Insurance: EIEC provides basic accident, medical and travel insurance to all participants.

Duty Hours and Off Days: No more than 20 hours per week, 1.5 days off per week.

Educational Components: Participants may receive online or onsite mandarin classes depending on arrival times and city. Local Coordinator organize monthly cultural activities.

Travel Days and Travel Bonus (for 60-day Program only) Participants receive 2 extra travel days within the program and 300USD travel bonus upon program successful completion.

Early Return Compensation: Participant who leaves the program before the agreed program end date will need to reimburse EIEC for provided trip expenses and educational fees pro rata.
